

Match Officials Code of Behaviour

- 1. Place the safety and welfare of the athletes above all else.
- 2. Be consistent and impartial when making decisions.
- 3. Address unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all people.
- 4. Modify your approach to suit the skill levels and needs of players.
- 5. Praise and encourage all participants.
- 6. Be consistent, objective and courteous when making decisions.
- 7. Do not tolerate unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all opponents.
- 8. Emphasize the spirit of the game rather than focus on negative aspects.
- 9. Encourage and promote rule changes to all players and members.
- 10. Be a good sport yourself, as actions speak louder than words.
- 11. Keep up to date with the latest trends in refereeing.
- 12. Remember that you set the example on the park, therefore, your behaviour and comments should always be positive and supportive.
