

## Players Code of Behaviour

- 1. Give your best at all times.
- 2. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit.
- 3. Play by the Rules.
- 4. Do not argue with the Match Official. If you disagree, have your captain or coach approach the Match Official during a break in play or after the match is concluded.
- 5. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking another person is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
- 6. Be a good sport and be prepared to acknowledge good play whether it is from your team or the opposition.
- 7. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- 8. Co-operate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them, there would be no competition.
- 9. Remove all jewellery prior to training and match play, as it is a hazard to you and those around you.
- 10. Do not accept or use any banned or unauthorised drug(s), including the consumption of alcohol at any time.
